



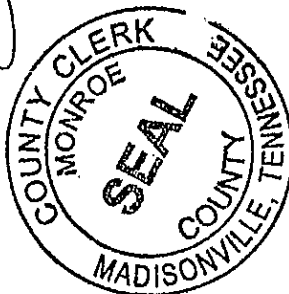

WHEREAS, Monroe County has authority to declare items as surplus that is no longer deemed necessary or adequate to properly perform the duties of county government as prescribed by law; and





CONVENIENCE CENTER IN THE NILES FERRY INDUSTRIAL PARK**



RESOLUTION TO OPT-OUT OF STATEWIDE BUILDING CODE STANDARDS FOR ONE-FAMILY AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS IN MONROE COUNTY

WHEREAS, T.C.A § 68-120-101 authorizes counties to opt-out of statewide building code standards for one-family and two-family dwellings within the county's jurisdiction outside any municipality located within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Monroe County for these standards not to apply to one-family and two-family dwellings within the county's jurisdiction outside any municipality located within the county;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County, meeting in regular session on this 27th day of September 2022, that statewide building code standards, adopted pursuant to Title 68, chapter 120, shall not apply to one-family and two-family dwellings located within the jurisdictional boundaries of Monroe County outside any municipality located within the county.
