#### RESOLUTION OF THE MONROE COUNTY COMMISSION APPROVING THE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF INMATE HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS: Monroe County (the "County") and the Monroe County Sheriff's Office ("Sheriff") desire to provide professional and responsive healthcare services to the inmates/detainees of the Monroe County Jail ("Jail"); and

WHEREAS: Fast Access Healthcare, LLC, d/b/a Fast Access Correctional Healthcare ("FAH") is a corporation that provides correctional healthcare services in incarceration facilities and desires to provide such services to the County annually, which shall be renewable for successive one (1) year terms, such renewals occurring automatically, unless either party gives ninety (90) days written notice prior to the end of the term, consistent with the provisions of the Agreement for the Provision of Inmate Health Services attached hereto as Exhibit A. Upon such automatic annual renewal, the annual amount shall increase by the greater of 3.5% or the current Consumer Price Index Wage and Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) Medical Care Component (MCC) for the Southern Region of the United States: and

WHEREAS: The County and Sheriff desire to enter into an Agreement with FAH: and

WHEREAS: Exhibit A has been reviewed and approved by the Monroe County Sheriff's Office, the Monroe County Finance Department, and has also been reviewed and approved as to form by the Monroe County Attorney.
