## **RESOLUTION NO: 527-7**

#### A RESOLUTION EFFECTING THE CLOSING OF KEY KILE ROAD

#### FROM SWEETWATER VONORE ROAD TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, die Monroe County Commission, on April 26, 2011, and pursuant to T.C.A. § 54-10-216, enacted Resolution No. 426-26, providing for the closing of public roads in the County that are not maintained by any other governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, Fairview Baptist Church, a religious organization located in Sweetwater, Monroe County, Tennessee, by written request to the Chief Administrative Officer of the Monroe County Highway Department dated <u>1/14/14</u>, has requested that approximately 660.93 feet from Sweetwater Vonore Road be closed to vehicular traffic for the safety of its attending church members and so they may install a new parking area for the church members; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Administrative Officer of the Monroe County Highway Department has previously provided advertised notice to interested parties as provided in T.C.A. § 54-10-216; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of the Monroe County Road Department issued a recommendation to the Monroe County Regional Planning Commission that the road be closed to vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Regional Planning Commission recommends that the Monroe County Commission close Key Kile Road to vehicular traffic. Fairview Baptist Church will continue to have use and access to this section of Key Kile Road;

IT IS ACCORDINGLY HEREBY RESOLVED that Key Kile Road be and the same is hereby declared to be closed to vehicular traffic by Monroe County through the adoption of this Resolution by a majority of the members of the Monroe County Commission, and from and after the date of this Resolution, Monroe County shall have no further responsibility for maintenance, upkeep, and repair of Key Kile Road.

This Resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval, the public welfare requiring it.
