# RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A CONTINUING BUDGET AND TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES FOR MONROE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, it appears that the 2014-2015 fiscal budget of Monroe County, Tennessee will not be approved during the 2014 July term of the Board of Commissioners;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Monroe County, Tennessee that the amounts set out in the 2013-2014 Appropriation Resolution are hereby continued until a new 2014-2015 Appropriation Resolution is adopted; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the property tax rate as adopted for the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year shall remain in effect for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 until a new tax rate is adopted: and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Mayor and County Clerk are hereby authorized to borrow money on tax anticipation notes, not exceeding 60% of the appropriations of each individual fund of the continuing budget to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes and other revenues for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 have been collected. Such notes shall first be approved by the State Director of Local Finance. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the authority of Title 9, Chapter 21, *Tennessee Code Annotated.* All of said notes shall mature and be paid in full without renewal not later than June 30, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and its provisions shall be in force from and after July 1, 2014.
